

# **Steps to Apply for a Team:**

#### **Step 1: Review the Team Requirements**

• Make sure you understand the all of the requirements for teams that are listed in this packet.

#### Step 2: Choose Your Summer Training Program

• Dancers are required to complete 16 hours of technique class during our 8-week summer session or participate in an equivalent dance camp or intensive program elsewhere. Instructors must sign off on these hours.

#### Step 3: Register for Your Chosen Summer Program

• Register for your chosen summer program to secure your spot. More details can be found here: <u>Summer Dance 2025</u>

#### Step 4: Submit your Application and complete the Team Audition

 Dancers can participate in our open class audition held in June. If you are unable to attend this class, we also offer the option to set up a private audition or class audition. Submit your team placement application by July 1st to be considered for the team.

#### **Step 5: Wait for Team Placement Decisions**

• You will receive notification of your team placement status by July 22nd.

#### Step 6: Confirm Your Team Placement

• If you are accepted onto a team, confirm your placement by July 26th to secure your spot. Make sure to follow any necessary steps to confirm your placement and prepare for the upcoming season.

#### Step 7: Attend the Mandatory Choreography Camp

• Participate in the mandatory choreography camp on August 4th-7th. This is a requirement for team placement, so make sure to clear your schedule and attend.

#### Step 8: Prepare for the Upcoming Season

- Get ready for an exciting season with Ovation Dance!
- Make sure to attend regular classes and rehearsals, and stay focused on your goals as a team member!

## **Joining Our Competition Teams**

**Team Placement Process:** The team placement process is conducted through class auditions, private audition or by instructor invitation. Placement decisions consider not only technical ability and team dynamics but also essential qualities such as a positive attitude, which fosters a supportive and collaborative environment; adaptability, demonstrating the ability to quickly learn choreography and embrace new styles; and a strong commitment to practice and team activities, which is crucial for both individual growth and the success of the team. Please note that team spots are limited and not guaranteed. If you are interested in being invited to join one of our Teams, please fill out the form below. It is mandatory for all dancers, including those who have been on a team before, to have a form on file to be considered for team placement.

#### **Ovation Dance Team Interest Form**

**Class Recommendation:** We strongly encourage each dancer to spend at least one dance season taking classes in Ballet, Tap, Jazz, or Acro at Ovation Dance.

**Summer Session Requirement:** Dancers are required to take 16 hours of technique class during our summer 8-week session or take classes at a dance camp/intensive program elsewhere. instructors must sign off on these hours. These sessions help assess growth, technique level, and commitment to skill improvement, which are key factors in team placement decisions.

**Class Schedule Design Assistance:** For assistance in designing a class schedule tailored to prepare your dancer for potential team opportunities, feel free to contact us. Private lessons are available to customize training to your dancer's goals, ensuring support and guidance on their dance journey at Ovation Dance.

**Invitation Process:** Invitations for the upcoming season's teams are sent out to dancers/parents throughout June and July.

# **Required Classes/Events for Team Members**

To ensure the success and development of our team members, the following classes/practices are mandatory for all team dancers.

Attendance and dedication to these required classes/practices are essential for team cohesion and improvement. Optional additional classes are also available to further broaden dance skills and knowledge.

## **Required Classes/Events for Team Members Cont.**

In addition to the mandatory classes and practices, our team members will have opportunities to participate in:

- **Conventions:** A weekend event where dancers take classes from well-known choreographers and learn from the industry's best. Parents may purchase an "observer band" to watch them in the classes all weekend, if they choose.
- **Competitions:** Weekend events where dancers and studios from various states compete in different dance categories. Our studio attends 1-4 competitions per year typically between February and April. Out of town travel and/or hotel stays may be necessary
- **Recitals:** Team dancers perform in the Spring Ovation Dance Recital, showcasing their progress and skills to friends, family, and the community.

Attendance and dedication to these events are vital for the growth and success of our team members. Optional additional classes and private lessons are available to further broaden dance skills and knowledge.

### **Team Fees**

Below is the breakdown of the costs associated with being a team member in terms of tuition, installment fees, and additional expenses:

#### **Monthly Tuition:**

- \*\*Spotlight & Limelight (2 Classes):\*\* \$104/month
- \*\*Premiere, Bravo, Encore (3 Classes):\*\* \$148/month

#### Team 9 Month Installment Fees (Costumes, Shoes, Competition/Convention Fees):

- Dependent on the number of routines
- \$75 \$125 per month

Team Jacket: \$65 - \$90 (one-time fee)

Additional Fees: - Extra Tights, Makeup & Hair Accessories: \$75

Studio Recital Fee: \$50 (February)

We recommend contacting the studio for specific details on payment plans, schedules, and any additional expenses that may arise throughout the season. Costs are subject to change, so it's crucial to discuss any financial concerns with the studio director or team coach.

The studio may provide fundraising opportunities to help reduce team-related expenses. Participation in fundraising activities can help cover costs like costumes, competition fees, and team items.
